## SUBJECT = MUSIC

### INTENT

- To deliver a high-quality music education which will engage and inspire our pupils to develop a love of music and their talent as musicians.
- Through participation, children will develop self-confidence, creativity and a sense of achievement.
- To develop children's musical intelligence.
- To sing in tune and with other people. Through singing they will learn about the structure and organisation of music.
- The Charanga Musical School Scheme will be used to develop innovative provision to meet the needs of all our pupils.
- To embed music across the Academy using a progressive curriculum across all key stages within the strands of music.
- To become familiar with and have an appreciation for musicians in our local community.

### IMPLEMENTATION

- Music will be taught in a sequence of progressive lessons.
- The Charanga Musical School Scheme will be used to develop the progression of musical knowledge and skills in line with the National Curriculum.
- To inspire children to sing in a weekly Glee Club.
- A love of music and performance will be enhanced through our dance provision.
- Weekly singing assemblies to develop pitch and a sense of melody.
- Performances to the local community.
- Academy Music Lead will monitor the provision of music.
- Peripatetic teachers to teach individual instruments to those wishing to learn and all children to learn how to play an instrument.

### IMPACT

- Every child has developed a love and an appreciation of music.
- Children will achieve age related expectations at the end of their cohort year.
- Children will have been given opportunities to perform and share their musical skills at events both in and outside our academy.
- Children have developed confidence and self-esteem.
