INTENT

- Completion of creative, home learning projects in which children are inspired to make full use of the natural environment.
- Children will work with local artists in our community to enrich our art curriculum.
- The provision of Art will be monitored by the Academy Art lead.
- Individual sketch books will be used to evidence work.
- Knowledge organisers will be utilised to support and track progression of knowledge and skills across the academy.
- Opportunities for pupils to showcase their work through our participation in local Art competitions, Art theme days and celebration assemblies.
